- Demonstrate a willingness to work in a collaborative environment and participate in weekly staff meetings.
- Be capable of working independently.
- Demonstrate excellent communication skills. Previous journalistic or media related experience is an asset, but not a necessity.
- Foster and contribute to an anti-oppressive work environment.

**Requirements:**

*Applicants must fit the Canada Summer Jobs requirements:*

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.
